

# Sea & Sea's MX-10 and Macro Lens

GET GREAT SHOTS ON YOUR FIRST TRY!

When divers first venture into underwater photography, positive results are critical to keep the interest sparked. The perfect camera system to achieve great photos in one easy try is the MX-10, by Sea & Sea Products, Ltd. The standard 32mm lens works great for photos of most reef scenics but there are also three additional lenses; one each for macro, close-up and wide angle. Best of all, you can change lenses underwater! Yes, we said underwater. We think the first lens to add to your basic MX-10 system is the macro. It is the easiest to use and will yield the highest amount of "keepers" in your first few photo expeditions.

The MX-10 system is designed to be compact and offer total freedom. The macro lens folds up when not in use, which streamlines it and makes it easy to carry. Sea & Sea even offers a lens caddy, which allows you to carry the macro lens underwater and put it on once you make the plunge.

When you unfold the lens, you will find it has three working sections. The lens itself has a bayonet mount and fits right onto the standard lens with just a twist of the wrist. The extension bar drops down and the framer wings can be moved into position. A single upright bar is mounted on the underside of the extension bar, out of the way until you make your dive. When you are ready to use the system, remove the bar and screw it into the right side of the framer wings until it is finger tight. The left side does not have an up-

war among the editors here at SKIN DIVER. For more than 20 years, this palm woven hat has been standard issue for beach lifeguards in Hawaii and Southern California. The five inch brim provides great protection against overexposure to the sun's harmful ultraviolet rays, especially for the often overlooked back of the neck area. This ultra light hat is one size fits "most." It has a nylon chinstrap with a spring-loaded tab to cinch up during windy conditions. Headhunter Lifeguard hats sell for \$19.95. ENTRECRAZE RUBBER BANDZ WATCH STRAP: These unique rubber watch bands are great for watersport wear. They are colorful, comfortable, won't absorb perspiration, odor or pull your wrist hairs. right bar so the flash won't throw a shadow on the background.

To use the macro lens, find an animal smaller than the four by six inch frame, place the framer up to your subject and press the shutter release. The focus point is at the front edge of the framer; the picture area is just less than the framer indicates, an important feature that keeps it out of your photos. Don't look through the viewfinder to line up your shot because you will have an incorrect depth perception. Instead, view the scene from a 45 degree angle off to the side of the camera. This allows you to place your subject at the front edge of the framer rather than through it, which will produce out of focus photos.

The best part of using this lens is that you don't need an extra flash to get good exposures. The MX-10 camera has an internal flash that has two settings—f/4.5 and f/11. When you use the macro framer set the camera to internal flash at f/11. Each photo will be illuminated correctly and have good depth of field.

There will be times when the water will contain particles that can cause backscatter in your photos. In less than clear water, don't use the internal flash, switch to the YS-40 or YS-40A. With both of these strobes the flash head is farther from the camera, resulting in less backscatter in your photos.

When shooting macro with the YS-40A, use f/16 for dark subjects and f/22 for normal and light subjects.

Creative lighting effects can be accomplished with the YS-40A by removing the flash from the camera and holding it over or behind your subject. For this type of photo you will need to set the internal flash to f/11. This will trigger the YS-40A so both flashes will illuminate the subject. You should hold the YS-40A at least 1.5 feet from the framer.

With the MX-10, you can take a picture on the beach one moment and U/W the next. You can photograph the reef using the normal lens and then a colorful nudibranch using the macro lens. No other manufacturer offers this kind of versatility in a camera system.
